Ever feel overwhelmed at the prospect of creating a leadership development plan for your local church? You're not alone.

You can start the program at any time. Remember that you'll need to schedule a monthly 90-minute time slot for each gathering and that each session includes a meal (time of fellowship), a presentation on the book, a discussion on the book (i.e., how it applies to their lives and how it applies to their role in the local church), and a monthly challenge (which is in response to the topic discussed).
